

① I suppose one question is asked more than any other / when we teach or preach / or what I believe is one of the Greatest & most Rewarding truths of the Bible outside of God's plan of Salvation

That's Not true, <sup>either</sup> the Bible says "all have sinned, all fall short of God's expectations" Rom. 3:23 ~~but a Christian is not~~

You know why - Become with  
God, there is no end —

② John 10: 28-30 You gotta hear  
this: "And I (Jesus), give them  
eternal life, // And they shall  
never perish // Neither shall  
any man pluck them out  
of my hand // My Father (God)  
which gave them me // is greater  
than all, // And no man is able  
to pluck them out of my  
Father's hand — ~~And they are safe~~

Now folks, "That's Heavy" As our  
Grandson used to say, "That's Awesome"

You See, to Accept the Biblical  
Truth of "Security of the Believer"  
One must have the proper  
Concept of what God Actually  
does & who God is

People who say:

- 1 I believe God has all Power
- 2 I believe He knows all things
- 3 I believe He is in all places

Will say:

I Just Don't Accept ~~that~~ <sup>Security of the</sup> Believer  
~~Security of the Believer~~

Well all I can say is: "You  
Must Not really Accept all  
the other things you claim  
to Accept About God Amos

I believe this: "If He can make  
it, He can sure keep it"

Listen to Romans 8:28-39  
(read it)

3/ Father listens to me: The Order  
Start for a person to lose their  
salvation, all these works  
of God would have to be  
undone. —

And no where in the Bible  
are we told that it could  
be undone or would be

How sad that.  
There are scriptures that take  
us to <sup>try</sup> do away with this  
truth. I don't, for the life  
of me figure out why  
anyone would want to  
do away with the truth.

Anyway Hebrews 6:6 <sup>is</sup> often  
used by people to discredit  
the once saved always saved  
Biblical Doctrine.

"If they should fall away" or  
all they read — they say  
"If" means "when"

It does not

Let's Read Verse 4 — 6 for proof

Rev:  
684

" For it is impossible for those who were once enlightened and have tasted the heavenly gift, and were made partakers of the Holy Spirit (And for you are not made a partaker of the Holy Spirit unless you are saved)

And in the Greek, "Partakers" means

Participant / sharer / partner in

And "Enlightened" means:

- ① Come to know the truth
- ② Embraced the truth
- ③ Saved

So this Scripture does not raise questions, A Sinner Answer.

V-5 And have tasted the good word of God, and the powers of the world to corrupt

V-6 If (it were possible <sup>that</sup>) they shall fall away. (Be lost)

4/ In order to Reverse them (or  
for them to be saved again)  
they would have to Crucify  
Christ over & over —

Now folks, if this Scripture teaches  
that one can lose their salvation  
(As some believe) it also teaches  
that one can never be saved  
a second time —

Here's why

Jesus said in John 19:30  
It's Finished / It's Done

Once & for all

Amen } I believe the work Christ  
did was enough — I don't believe  
He left any loose ends —

And the reason I believe it, is  
because the Bible teaches it.

Oh dear hearts, what do you  
base the keeping on?

Your Power or

God's Power

We know, you can't —

IN 1 Cor. 12:13 Paul writes.

"For by One Spirit (The Holy Spirit) one we all Baptized into one Body"

It is God's Holy Spirit who joins us to Christ // The tense, in 1 Cor. 12:13 is "Past Tense" To the saved, (It's Been Done)

It is something All Believers have experienced

He Says: "You have God's
