

Have you ever been told that something was true, but you really wondered about it —

Maybe you went to a doctor one time and he told you that the thing you were so worried about was nothing at all — But you weren't convinced and wanted some assurance —

Well some people have the same problem with promises that God has made in the Bible. They read parts of the Bible, and would really like to believe it. But they don't read far enough to get assurance that they need —

The Bible tells us that "God is love" In 1 John 4:8 the Bible says: "To know God, is to know His love, for God is love"

in J-10 the Bible says: "Here is  
is Love, Not that we loved God  
but that He loved us"

I suppose all of us can remember  
as children that one of the  
first things we were taught is  
Sunday School with "God is Love"

And as children we simply accepted  
that // As children we did not  
question the truth of that statement.

But when people get older, they  
begin to question // They look  
for proof or for Assurance -

But they don't go to the right  
place for it -

The word Assurance means

- ① Something positive
- ② a Guarantee
- ③ Something Certain
- ④ It means the person will back  
up the product -

② When I buy something I usually ask for a guarantee I want to know there is something behind the product -  
I want something I can rely on -

Well the Bible gives us all the proof we need - we just need to find out what it is -

We said earlier that the Bible tells us that "God loves us"  
But where is the proof -  
What is the evidence?

In 1 John 4:10 we read that God loved us, even tho we did not love Him - By where is the proof -

In that same verse the Bible says. "To prove His love, God allowed His son Jesus to be a substitute for us - He took the punishment that we deserved -"

It was God's Guarantee / God's  
Backing up His word / Proof that  
God loved us —

I will not leave you without a  
New to add to that. The Bible  
tells us that "God sent His  
Holy Spirit" to give us  
Assurance

In 1 John 4:13 the Bible says:  
So we might know (or have  
Assurance) that God dwells  
in us, He gave us His Holy  
Spirit as a guarantee —

The 3rd Person of the Trinity (real)  
The Holy Spirit of God dwells in  
the heart of every believer — He  
has a job to do — guide, direct  
lead by His working

- ① To let us know that we belong to God
- ② To let us know what God expects  
of us —
- ③ To help us understand His word —
- ④ To tell us when we are wrong
- ⑤ And to show us how to get  
back in God's good grace —

3/ And God's Holy Spirit Also tells us  
that what we have placed in  
God's hands is safe. —

Someone Asked Me One day, "How do  
you know you are saved?"

(And that's a good question)

They Also Asked "How do you know  
you will not lose your salvation?"

(And that's a good question too)

You see unless we had all the  
guarantees God makes about  
our salvation, we could have  
questions about it —

Now let me answer the first question  
"How do I know I'm saved?"

And the answer is: Because God's  
word says — "If I do what  
God says I must do, He  
guarantees to do what He  
promised to do —"

in Romans Chapter 10 the Bible  
tells us "That if we will confess  
with our mouth the Lord  
Jesus, and believe in our  
hearts that God has raised  
Jesus from the dead, we  
will be saved"

New Faith, That's God's  
Guarantee,

And then Romans 10:13 which  
says: "Whosoever will call on  
the Name of the Lord will  
be saved" Is further  
Guarantee, and a word of  
Assurance from God Himself —

But in spite of all God's word here  
to say about God's Guarantee  
and Assurance, people ~~still~~  
still question God —

You see our problem is we  
depend too much on self  
and too little on God

4 Father, let me tell you something,  
If God said it, you and  
I can believe it — Amen

And if we Ask Jesus to save us  
And believe in our hearts what  
the Bible says we must do we  
have God's Guarantee that  
He will

- ① Save us eternally
- ② And keep us eternally —

Listen to what Jesus said: In John's  
Chapt. 10 the Lord Jesus said this:  
"I give those who believe in  
me eternal life / And they  
shall never perish // Neither  
shall any man pluck them  
out of my hand"

And to add more strength to what  
He had said, Jesus went on to say  
"My Father, God, which gave them  
to me (or who saved them) is  
greater than ALL, And no man  
is able to pluck them out of my  
Father's hand —

Let me Ask a Question - Have you  
ever given your heart to Jesus?  
Do you remember the time you  
asked Jesus to save you - &  
you remember that you believed  
what the Word of God said  
about Jesus?

Then dear hearts God's Word  
says - You have God's Word,  
that what you placed in  
His hands is safe, and will  
be safe forever -

You see our being saved depends  
on God keeping His Word, And our  
staying saved forever depends on  
God keeping His promise -

I don't know about you, but  
God's Word is guarantee enough  
for me - God's Word is all  
the assurance I need - Amen!

Dear hearts, the Bible says "God is Love"  
And it also says: God proved His  
love for us every way possible -



5/ And the Bible says: Put your faith  
And trust in God and in His word  
And all His promises will be  
yours —

Let me Ask - "Do you believe  
that God speaks only the truth?"

Do you believe that God is able  
to do all He promised?

Then trust Him Completely, Let  
His word be Assurance enough —

With this We Close:

"God is my Refuge, And my  
Strength, He's Always near  
when I need Him, He will  
never go back on a promise  
He has made - Therefore  
I will not fear whatever  
comes, for I believe God  
And Accept His word as  
truth" Psalm 46:1-2
