of sinning —

2/ Dear Ones, the Bible says
that the children of God
become New Creatures
when they are saved —

Not perfect yet, But working
at it Ames —

May I ask a Very Frank
Question —

① What's different about you
now than before you came
to know Christ as Savior?

② Is there a difference?

The Scripture we read says
this:

Those who really belong
to God, do not make
the practice of sin a
common thing in their
lives —

Why? Because One in Christ
has taken on the nature of God

God's Nature is Good —
Satan's Nature is evil —

New born Ones, The Bible says

" If you can live on you
did before you claimed
to be saved And have
No Regrets — Something's Wrong

Note the Contrast between
God's Children & the Devils.

V-8 He that Committeth
Sin — Is of the Devil —

Oh Wow, Does this mean that
when I cursed, I lost my
salvation NO

Does it mean that when I
got drunk, I lost my salvation
NO

Does it mean that when
I lied I lost my
salvation —
Absolutely Not

3/ But it does mean, "If you can do it & not have regret you need to go back to the "Beginning" And be sure, something really happened.

U-8 Means this:

HABITUAL - Willing - Smiling
is ~~indicative~~ indicative
of a deep problem.

It means those who show no remorse have taken on the character of the devil —

Now

who introduced sin	(the devil)
who promoted sin	(the devil)
who encouraged sin	(the devil)
who enjoys sin most.	(the devil)

Why the devil smiled before the beginning — Our first account of him speaks of sin —

The rebellion in Heaven when Satan & his followers were created occurred before time as we know it.

2 Peter 2:4. Speaks of
them, or those who left
their own habitations"

But now wait for
judgement —

Little is said of this Rebellion
Against God — when the devil
sought to take over —

Dear One there are some
things God has kept to
Himself

But He's told us of the
influence of this evil one
who is going about seeking
whom He may destroy

The
Devil's

influence says:

① Do it, No One will ever know
(But God does)

② His influence says: I won't
tell a soul —

(He's a liar)

He tells others who are weak

we started talking about
Heaven, and now we
talking about Hell —

Started talking about Good,
now we are on evil things.

No Dear Ones, this is still Good

For we need to know what there
is different between the lost
and the saved — Amen.

U-10 says. Here's how you
can tell the difference

① God's people hunt when they
are disobedient.
(The devils don't)

② God's people know when the
breach occurs —
(The devils could care less)

Who's side are you on?
How do you feel about sin.

Let me allow you in on a
Secret —

① I know exactly when I sin —
(I'm do)

② I know exactly when my
spirit is grieved —
(I'm do)

Oh Dear One, there better not
be in Helen's shoes than's
Ansel here —

For we all fall short of God's
expectation of us —

One day Jesus went up on
the mount of Olives to have
time alone with God —

Aid to prepare Him for
what ever come next.
