

Sunday A.M. 3/13/88 "Hell, No place to Go"

"Get their Attention before message"

Jesus said: "This is my Father's House,
when you come into it, worship my
Father" / To do so, you must listen
to His messenger" **He used different
words in Matt. 21:13** But I believe
this was His message —

So I'm asking that we ALL give attention to
God's word today — No Note writing, / No
unnecessary talking or moving about —
**You could Quench the Holy Spirit
And be the cause of someone
Going to hell — ok —**

"Hell" is the Message today" No place
to Go

As God began to deal with our hearts, on
a request made by a precious lady
in this church, we asked for a word
that would be most descriptive of hell —
The first word that came to mind
was "Ge-hennom" And here's why

It speaks of a place where a fire
burned continually // a place
where that which was rejected
was cast // a place of
separation

a place where the Lord Jesus said
"The worm never dieth, and the
fire is never quenched" (Mark 9:46)

Dear hearts, to understand the awfulness
of hell, you must understand why there
is such a place - why we ask,
would a God who loves so much
ever prepare a place like hell?

Matthew said this about hell. "It is
a place of everlasting fire,
prepared for the devil and his
angels - Matt. 25:41

And someone will surely say: "Oh, I need
not worry" - "I'm not the devil, and
I'm not his angel. Oh but let
me ask, whose side are you on?"

who is your life committed to?

"If you are not of the family of God, having been saved by believing on the Lord Jesus, and by receiving Him as your Saviour, you're on the Wrong Side — Amen —"

You're aligned yourself with the one who is opposed to God // And who is opposed to God? The devil and his angels or his followers —

That takes care of part of the question. The other part of the reason for hell is a place of eternal separation for those who did not choose to accept the gift God offered so freely —

The Word of God is very specific Dear hearts
"Hell is just as real as Heaven"
One separates the believer from God for all eternity, the other is a place of eternal bliss for all eternity —

what can be said about the place
called hell? Nothing Good —

Let me Ask a Question, "what could be
worse than being Separated from
all that's Good / all that's kind /
all that's loving —

Hell is a place where the believers will
be forever Separated from God, and
God is all we loved, and so much more.

Look at Matt. 7:23 How Jesus Speaks
of Unbelief — They will profess unto
them, "I never knew you" Depart from me.
Be forever Separated from me.

The Greek word for Depart means more
than Cut out of my sight / or Go Away
It Means:

- ① Be Separated from me Completely.
- ② Be Separated from me throughout.
- ③ Be Separated from me, never to return.

what an Awful thought?

what an Awful Condition to be in —

You see, even now the just and the
the just enjoy the Blessings of God.
(Believers & unbelievers if you please)
But one who dies to wake in hell will
be forever separated from the Blessings
of God —

now we have heard that which speaks
of those who will inhabit this place
the Bible calls hell —

for the next few minutes we
want to speak about the place
itself.

We already heard from Jay: "Hell is a
place prepared for the prepared people"
people who are in opposition to God
(Matt. 25:41)

We have heard from Jay: "The Worm Never
dies there, and the fire burns forever"
Mark. 10:46

We heard from Jay "Hell is a place of
eternal separation" ~~Mark~~ Matt 7:23

But He didn't stop there, In Matt. 2
46 Jesus calls hell a place
of everlasting punishment.

This is Luke 16, Jesus 22 - 31
Our Lord Jesus tells about a man
who died and woke up in hell.

His name is not mentioned but
a Jerry David picture of this
place called Hell is given.

The word "Tortments" is used in U. 23

The Greek word for this suggests

① a terrible condition of suffering -

② An indescribable anguish -

③ Pain beyond imagination -

The word is Plural, meaning

① Not just one condition of suffering, but many.

② Not just one type of anguish, but many.

③ Not just a pain, but many -

And this passage speaks of fire

"Only a finger tip in water,

placed on the tongue would

be ~~offered~~ welcomed -

But the word comes back, Not possible,

You were told Agassiz & Agassiz what to expect -
And Jesse 26 speaks origin of
Separation - "A Great Gulf Fixed"
