If there is one question that would be very appropriate for every Believer here to ask of God, It would surely be:

"Lord, what would you have me to do? (Amen)"

Not, "Lord, what would you have them do / "But Lord, what would you have me to do"

We have a tendency today to hedge on our Assignment from God

There is evidence that many would be satisfied to play in the Band, if there was no practices involved —

But that's not God's way —

I'm convinced that God has a job for every Believer / And He doesn't expect us to push it off on someone else —

We need to listen for God's  
call, and we need to set us  
it when it comes —

In 1 Samuel It is recorded  
that a woman prayed for a  
son.

{ She did not pray once and  
quit - She prayed much

She wept as she prayed  
she cried out to God

One day she prayed this prayer:

"Oh God, hear the cry of  
child

Give me a son, and  
he will be dedicated  
to you —

God heard the prayer and  
gave Hannah a son —

when the child was yet  
at a tender age she  
took him to the place of worship

and left him in the care  
of Eli, the priest — to be  
used of God —

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wouldn't it be wonderful  
if today, parents would be  
so willing for God to  
use their children —

Oh but what we need to note  
here, it wasn't just the  
willingness of the parent,  
But also the obedience of  
the son.

God called the child's name.

Samuel, Samuel, and the  
child believing it was Eli  
replied, "Here Am I"

The priest assumed the Lord that  
he had not called and sent  
Samuel back to bed —

And God called again.

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Tom convinced there are 2 voices

They do not discern the spirit  
of he who speaks -

But in Acts 9, Verse 5 He  
God let Saul know who was on  
the line - Amen

The Voice said: "From Jesus, you're  
working on the wrong job -  
you've been at the wrong assignment."

And Saul said: "Lord, Lord,  
"what will you have me do?"

And there a message there for  
us -

Be sure you're in tune with God  
when you hear a voice, Be sure  
it's God on the line -

Listen to what He says, then  
commit yourself to the task  
Assigned -

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Do you really want to hear from God,  
then listen with your spiritual ears

Do you really want to know what  
your assignment is, then ask God,  
Place yourself at His disposal

And when He tells you what He  
would have you do - Get at it -
