We need to see God and

In 2 Kings Chapt. 6 there is the
Account of Elisha being delivered
by God — The Account also
includes a prayer the prophet
prayed — (Read v. 8-17)

I love to read that, and do very
often — Simply because it's
so relevant to this day —

God does not promise us
an easy way if we give
ourselves over to Him —
He does not say we will be
free from persecution but He
does promise us His presence —

How often we are prone to
think like Elisha's servant.

How often we allow circumstances
to cause our faith to waver
And how often we leave ourselves
open to fear of man, rather
than to lean on the Arms of
the Father.

As Elisha prayed the prayer of
faith the situation seemed hopeless.

All the servant saw was
the enemy —
He went to his master with a
message laced with fear. All
he had seen were swords
glistering in the sunlight, all
he saw was men & animals
& chariots. All he saw was problems.

You see the man has a lot of
relatives living today — folks
who are defeated because they
allow themselves to be limited
to a great faith. "That, they who
be with us are more than they
that be against us."

The Apostle John put it this way
 in 1 John 4:4 "Greater is
 he that is in you than he
 that is in the world"

Father, We Need Our Eyes Opened

{ We need to see that, with
 God nothing is impossible.

{ We need to see that we
 have no reason to fear
 if we are about the
 Father's business.

We Need Our Eyes Opened to
 the needs about us —

{ Souls need to be reached
 in the Name of Jesus

Elisha prayed: Lord, Open the eyes of this man, he needs to see
