

# "Let your Mind be Jesus"

Just last Wednesday Night As we  
Came back from Bryson I heard  
a preacher on the Radio read  
Psalm 19:14

And as I listened, I thought,  
This must have been what Paul had  
in mind when he wrote "Let this  
mind be in you which was also  
in Christ Jesus (Phil. 2:5)"

Now here's what Psalm 19:14 says:

"Let the words of my mouth and  
the meditations of my heart be  
acceptable in thy sight O Lord,  
my strength and my Redeemer"

How sweet those words are, and  
they should reflect the desire of  
our heart.

But you've heard and I've heard  
people who say "I'm a Christian" say  
things that are not acceptable to  
God —



You've heard and I've heard people  
say they are like Christ (And that's  
what Christ means) express thoughts  
and desires of the heart that must  
certainly be unacceptable to God —

And because of that, we would  
have to agree that they do not have  
the mind of Christ.

Now hear what the psalmist said: O God  
I don't ever want anything to come  
out of my mouth that does not  
magnify you // I want every word,  
spoken in secret or openly to cause  
someone to know that I love & adore  
you, and that my mind is constantly  
as you —

The psalmist also said: O God, let my  
dearest thoughts or desires be  
those that you'll accept and always  
approved // Let them be satisfying  
to you // Let them be agreeable  
to you, and I pray that they  
will bless you —



Now I believe the psalmist was doing  
exactly what you said I need to be  
doing. Continually - Acknowledging God,  
And Desiring His everything to be  
under God's Control

He was Desiring God to influence  
His every Action & A heart's  
Desire —

He was Anxious to please God //  
More Anxious than He was to  
please man —

He Desired to be accepted by God  
more than He desired to be accepted  
by man — And Father, to this day and  
time that poor Get a preacher is  
troubled with man — but please the  
heart of God —

And Dear hearts that's how it ought to  
be with you and me — And it can  
be if our love for the Lord  
exceeds all other love —

Oh but brethren, "I can't" / the peer  
pressure is too Great



I'll not be accepted by them // Well I  
tell me now what's more important  
Being Acceptable to God or to  
Human peers?

Yes You Can Be Acceptable to God //  
You Can do All Things to please God //  
But you have to Rely on the  
Strength available through Jesus  
Christ to do it. Paul says,  
"All you need is available" Phil 4:13  
And if you have the mind  
of Christ you'll want to  
please God in all things //

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Now the balance it used 3 words that  
Give us the secret to success is Being  
Acceptable to God pleasing God.

1st the word: "O Lord" (Jesus must be  
Land of our lives —

2nd the word: "My Strength"  
Now the word "Strength" is the Hebrew  
Can be interpreted "Rock" "a foundation  
that will stand"



3/ "Strength" is also a reference to a "Safe Place" // a hiding place // "And if ever we come close to having the mind of Christ, our Foundation must be on Him"

Then the psalmist used the word "Redeemer" but he did not refer to just "A" Redeemer, he said: "My Redeemer"

Now the word "Redeemer" as used here can also refer to "one who rescues"

One who redeems or rescues us from the penalty of our sins - One who we can have the utmost confidence in

Job used the same word confidently when in the midst of his afflictions  
cried out: "I know my Redeemer liveth, and that he shall stand at the latter day on the earth"

Let me ask, "How can one have the mind of Christ, and not have confidence?"



How can one have the mind of Christ  
and not acknowledge God for all He  
is? (They can't)

Oh but the Sabatist heart was overflowing  
with confidence // His heart overflowed  
with joy // And He acknowledged that  
His salvation began and ended in  
God — and all He wanted to do was  
worship God & bless Him — //

Please look at Philip's Chapt. 2  
Well what about Jesus? // What was the  
desire of His heart? //

He too desired to please God,  
for He knew who & what God was

Now after Jesus prayed "Not my will  
but Thy will be done" // O God,  
my mind is set on you and on  
your ways, and I find pleasure  
in you & please you"

Let me ask: Is that how it is with you?  
Is your mind set on God? // are  
you happy when you know your  
life blesses God / Is it enough?



4. If it is, "You have the mind of Jesus"

What about the mind of Jesus? What does it say to us?

I believe it says to us, As He was Humble, So should we be Humble. // Never was there a man who lived who could come close to being as Humble as Jesus, "Even tho He was Equal with God" yet the Bible tells us to work at it.

I believe the mind of Jesus <sup>conveys this message</sup> ~~says~~ to every believer "Be One with the Father"

In His Image // of His Spirit // Subject to His will

Oh but remember, "Bride won't Allow it" // IT'N not Allow Gods Image to show thru.

Bride will not allow our spirit to be in us with His spirit // IT'N not Allow us to be subject to His will (but Humility will allow it)



Oh listen Dear hearts, Part of the Reason  
we have Revival is to Remind ourselves  
that we must humble ourselves // that  
there is only room for One on the  
throne and that's Jesus // We  
have Revival efforts to show men  
that they need to draw Near to God  
so He may draw Near to us —

We have Revival efforts to encourage  
Believers to look at Self // And to  
see if the reflection is in God's  
Image —

We have Revival Efforts to encourage  
Believers to Commit that which they  
have held back from God

As Paul Reflected on the Mind of  
Christ He Reminds us that, "Jesus  
emptied Himself, taking on the  
form of a servant" And folks  
if Servanthood was on the  
Mind of Christ, it sure ought  
to be on our minds - Amen



Oh history "It seems to me that  
some one who refuses to submit  
their will / one who refuses to  
empty self and become a servant  
to Christ is saying: "I'm better  
than the law"

And the word of God says - No Way

Paul also said: "Christ was obedient to  
death" / "he subjected himself to  
the law of God and obeyed it"

"The highest honor that has ever been  
shown to the law of God on earth  
was when it was perfectly observed  
by the who made the law"

Oh history, "The mind of Jesus was set on  
being obedient, no matter what the  
cost, and it cost him his life —

Now it may not cost us our life,  
but if we have the mind of Christ  
we will be obedient even unto death.



Jesus died on the Cross // **we need to die to self** // oh listen, that too is why we have Revival efforts, In Essequibo  
It

**God rewarded Jesus, And He will reward us too** // Not as He did Jesus, but if we have the mind of Christ, that won't matter to us.

In Phil. 2:9 Paul wrote: "Wherefore God also hath highly exalted Him (Jesus) and given Him a Name which is above every Name."

**The word "Exalted" means "lifted up"** // lifted up with praise //

**And what about that Name? Fearful / Lord / Son of God // One worthy of our worship //**

Oh listen, when I read Phil. 2:9-11 I feel the need to fall on my face and worship Jesus // Paul said "One day every knee will"



Listen to Verse 10 & 11 "That at the Name of  
Jesus every knee shall bow of things  
in Heaven, And things in the earth,  
And things under the earth" And  
every tongue shall Confess that  
Jesus Christ is Lord, to the  
Glory of God the Father"

Jesus, Jesus, Jesus, shows just something  
about that name - Jesus

What does hearing these words do to  
you? What does it call you to do?

Oh it says to my heart, "Worship God and  
braise the Name of Jesus" // It makes  
me see that I'm not yet where  
God wants me to be // But it  
makes me want to be, and witness  
to be —

One behind, part of the effort to  
have revival is to get believers  
to want to have the mind of  
Christ —



We won't get the rewards from God,  
but if we have the mind which  
was also in Christ from, it won't  
matter at all

Please bow your heads, & close your eyes  
and let me ask -

① What is your mind set on Right Now?  
I hope it's on Jesus. I hope  
it's to have a mind like His -  
I hope it's set on listening to God

Are you saved? Are you living like it?  
Are you lifting up the Name of Jesus?  
Are you sold out to Jesus?

If you're saved, and not sold out to Jesus,  
you may be giving someone an excuse  
to sin -

would you talk to God about it  
then make the commitment God tells  
you to make - and then come  
share it with all of us?



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Are you lost? *Unsaved because of unbelief?* You can be saved Bright Now — Come let me tell you how.

I'll assure you, along with all the best of us, that one day we will all fall on our faces before Jesus.

Would Acknowledge Him as Lord

And the best will be compelled to admit how wrong they were. — *Why not admit you are wrong now, and Acknowledge your need to be saved*
