The Bible says: "God does not take lightly to this"

In fact, the Bible promises "The Judgment of God," will be poured out on those people —

And people ask "what do you mean by the Judgment of God?"

The Dictionary says "Judgment" is

- ① A legal decision
- ② An order of punishment
- ③ A debt resulting from a court order
- ④ Punishment for wrong doing.

Now the Bible says: "Only One Person has the right to Judge" who is it?

"Jesus" In The Gospel of John,
chapter 5 Verse 22 we read
"For the Father, Judgest no
man, But hath committed
All Judgement to the Son"

Now we said earlier that there are
people who do not preach the
truth about "Judgment of God"

They say: "But God is a Loving God
He will not judge or punish His
people"

Dear Hearts, God is A Loving God//
He is Also A Holy God

And because "Holiness" tops all the
other Natures of God, He can not
Allow Unholiness or Sinfulness
or Disobedience to go unpunished

① What did your ~~Parents~~ do when
you disobeyed them
They corrected you why?
Because they loved you —

As A parent, what did you do when
your child disobeyed you?

you punished them or
Corrected them —

why? Because you loved them

Now God punishes or Corrects for
the very same reason —

Because He loves us —

Now, Before you punished or
Corrected your children, you
had to look at what they had
done to see if it called for
punishment. Right —

You had to "Make A Judgment"
"you had laid down rules on a
parent, you had no doubt
let your children know
what those rules were —
(right)

Now, Because you did, they could not
rightfully say you were wrong when
you punished them for doing wrong.

You had made a judgement based
on facts —

And As A Good parent, you
had to do what you promised
to do —

That's how the judgement of God works

Heb. 12:2 says: "Fear whom the Lord
corrects, He chasteneth"

The word "chasteneth" means:

Educate - Instruct - Discipline
Teach by example —

Before the judgement of God, on the
charactering of God, is poured out
on people — God must judge
these people // He must look at
the evidence before Him —

And Because God is Holy
He MUST deal with
Unholiness —

God judges, because He loves.

And He gave out His Judgement
because He is Holy

"Judgement of God" is taught in the
Old Testament as well as the New

Psalms 96:1-3 "For He cometh
to judge the earth, (And when
He doeth) He will judge with
Righteousness — And with
truth"

When God judges, we can be sure
He has all the evidence. We can
be sure that whatever God does
mark'd deserves —

In Acts 17:31 we read: "Because He
hath appointed a Day, in the which
He will judge the world in
Righteousness by that man whom
He hath ordained, whereof He
hath given Assurance unto all
men, in that He hath raised Him
from the dead"

We said earlier that God always tells people the Rules the game will be played by - And He does -

Hebrews 9:27 says: "Just as it is appointed unto man once to die, so it is appointed unto man to appear before the judgment"

Now, Dear People, God is not trying to scare us, He is not trying to look like a mean person -

He's simply letting us know the Rules -

Now // Let me Ask a Question
Having heard what the Bible says, and knowing that God loves us, do we have the right to say - "God is not fair"
Absolutely Not

For the Bible tells us what to expect - Amn

And because it does we don't have
An excuse to stand on.

Your children had no excuse
 My children had no excuse
 And God's children have no
 excuse —

We said earlier that Jesus would
 be the final judge —
 what gives Him that right?

His death, Burial & Resurrection
 does — Amen

- ① Because He is the Son of God
 (He has the right to judge)
- ② Because He is equal to God
 (He has the right to judge)
- ③ Because He is God, (He has
 the right to judge)

Now, The Bible says "we shall
 all stand before the judgment
 seat of Christ" 2 Cor. 5:10
 Who does this speak of
 'Christians'?"

Not for our sins // (They have already
been judged) "But to have our
works judged"

What's so beautiful is that our
sins have already been judged.
Jesus did that on the cross,

When He Said "It is Finished"

And when we become Christians

the price for our sins was
paid —

You see the Bible says: "The wages
of sin is death —"
