He has ways to remind us that it belongs to Him —

The Book of Daniel records a very dramatic incident in the life of Nebuchadnezzar a King who had to learn the hard way that glory belongs to God —

This was the same King who had thrown 3 Jews in the furnace for refusing to bow down to a Golden Image — some 90 feet tall & 9 feet wide

The men refused to bow down & give anyone glory that belonged to God

The threat of death itself  
did not cause them to  
bow down before a false  
Image — of a deity.

God protected them  
because of their  
actions and caused  
a King to consider  
his own throne  
before God —

Chapter 4 is the result —

In verses 1 & 2 & 3 the King  
pays homage to the one  
true God —

- ① He speaks of Sijon  
& Wonders wrought  
by God —
- ② About His Kingdom  
having no end —

Here is one speaking who  
learned well his lesson

4 There is but one God  
And He is due all the  
Glory -

The King spoke of his  
former attitude -

① He had placed his  
security in worldly  
things -

② He had felt that he was  
a self made man,  
deserving no more,  
any thing -

But God allowed the King  
to have a dream, a vision,  
if you please -

And in the vision he  
saw things that troubled  
him greatly -

First, there was a great  
tree, and it grew  
so tall it reached up  
into the heavens.

And it spread out so far  
that you could not see  
the ends of the links.

Everything about the tree  
was lovely  
The leaves & the fruit  
were something to behold.

There was room for all  
the birds to nest therein.

But then the beauty part  
of the vision changed  
to a fearful sight -

An Angel cried out: Cut  
the tree down, leaving  
only a stump -

Cut the branches off  
scatter the leaves and  
fruits -

And chase all the  
birds away -

3) a beautiful dream become

was all part of God's

I am the greatest ever -

I have built a kingdom  
single handed

In King Nebuchadnezzar  
be the glory -

The forest tree is  
cut down -

all the birds are gone  
You no longer have  
a kingdom - Now will

you see v. 23 Speaks  
of tender grass -

Wet with dew

To be eaten by the  
beasts of the field -

And Gods sentence on this  
Proud / important King was  
that he would live like  
an animal until he repented  
And so it was for 7 years.

at the end of 7 years  
his one hand was lifted  
his eyes toward Heaven  
and said: "Lord, do not  
leave me here."
